PRIVACY POLICY -- 2016

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I. Our Pledge to You

The Putnam County Community Foundation is committed to maintaining the confidentiality, integrity, and security of personal information entrusted to us by all persons and organizations, including but not limited to: volunteers, current donors, potential donors, persons applying for scholarships, nonprofit agencies seeking funding, the people the nonprofits may serve, etc. We work hard to preserve your privacy and to insure that your preferences are honored.

II. Collection and Use of your Personal Information

Collecting personal information is essential to our ability to serve the community. In general personal information is voluntarily provided to us through correspondence, phone calls, and meetings. If necessary, we may utilize online resources and phone books or contact families and friends.

We maintain organized records of personal information for a variety of purposes including but not limited to business operations, gift facilitation, tax receipting, gift planning, reporting, recognizing, etc. We also use this information to provide you with information, keeping you up-to-date on our services, programs, and benefits, as well as the local community to better meet your philanthropic needs.

III. How We Share Information

Information about donors and volunteers, such as lists of committee members, is provided in several of our publications, including our annual report. We periodically publicize information about donors for recognition purposes. Our policy is to publicly recognize donors through our Cumulative Donor Honor Roll and our Annual Membership list unless instructed not to do so.

The law requires us to share information about current and former donors with government agencies or authorized third parties under certain circumstances, and permits us to share information with authorized third parties for valid and legal business reasons, such as to complete a grant application or for our annual external audit. In addition, we may be required to share information in response to IRS requirements, subpoenas, or to comply with certain laws.

We will not sell, rent, loan, or otherwise share any personally identifying information you provide with any individual or organization outside of the Community Foundation. We never sell information to third parties, nor do we share information about you to organizations for them to contact you for their own marketing or solicitation purposes.

IV. How We Protect Information

We strive to protect your data and safeguard it from those not authorized to see it. We restrict access to your personal information to those employees who need to know that information to provide services to you. We maintain physical, computer, electronic, file storage and procedural safeguards to guard your personal information.

A link to a website is not an endorsement, authorization, sponsorship, or affiliation with respect to such site, its owners, or providers.
