- 3. You deliver the grain to the elevator. Transfer the grain as a gift to PCCF.
- 4. PCCF will provide you with a receipt for your gift.
- 5. PCCF will sell the grain and receive the sale proceeds. Any sales invoice will name PCCF as the seller of the grain.
